

Outside Burning Regulations

A written permit is required before any outside burning is started.

After the written permit is issued a telephone call on the day you wish to burn is required to ascertain if weather conditions are acceptable for burning and to activate your permit for the day.

Permit is for brush only; piles of leaves are not permitted.

Never use Gasoline or other Flammables to start a fire.

The disposal by burning of brush from January 15 to May 1 shall be conducted:

- At a location greater than 75' from any dwelling,
- Between 10:00 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- On land proximate to the place of generation.
- While in constant attendance and until extinguished.

Must have a garden hose present and ready for use where the burning is taking place.
