Mr. Corvi motioned to accept the minutes from the March 29, 2022, open session meeting. Mr. Low seconded the motion, and it was unanimously accepted.

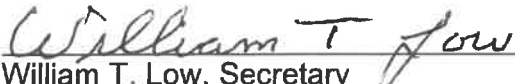
