The Abington & Rockland Joint Board of Water Commissioners held a meeting on June 17, 2021, at 3:30 p.m. at the Abington & Rockland Joint Water Works Office, 366 Centre Ave, Rockland, MA. Present were the following Commissioners:

Mrs. Donnelly motioned to approve the minutes from the May 11, 2021, meeting. Mr. Corvi seconded the motion, and it was unanimously accepted.

Eric Celidino requested to be on the agenda regarding a high consumption billing. Mr. Celidino was not in attendance. Mr. Lapointe explained the high billing to the Board. Mr. Corvi motioned to give Mr. Celidino time to pay. Mrs. Donnelly seconded the motion, and it was unanimously accepted.
