The purpose of this email is to notify you of a Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) as required by 314 CMR

16.00.

On <u>January 10, 2024</u>, at <u>11:00am</u> there was a sanitary sewer discharge or overflow at the Rockland

Wastewater Treatment Plant due to the recent heavy rain. The discharge or overflow consists of partially

treated sewage.

On <u>1/18/2024 at 1:00am</u> the discharge or overflow of the partially treated sewage ended. The total

discharge lasted 182 hours. As of 8:00am this morning the current flow is 4.8 MGD at a facility that has

a design limit of 2.5 MGD.

The estimated volume of the discharge or overflow of the partially treated sewage was recorded at

6,895,845 gallons.

The water bodies and land areas affected and/or potentially affected include the following:

• French's Stream

Avoid contact with this water body for 48 hours after the discharge or overflow ceases due to increased health risks from bacteria and other pollutants. See the website below for more information on whether
