INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

The Abington Water Department invites bids for Emergency Excavation and Paving Services for the period September 12, 2024, through June 30, 2027.

HOURLY BID

A list of the anticipated hours and equipment required is attached. The list is provided solely for the purpose of comparison of bids and the Town of Abington reserves the right to increase or decrease the hours or equipment required in accordance with their needs. It is understood that the contractor will provide the hours and equipment required by the Town of Abington on an as-needed basis throughout the Term.

BIDS MAY BE HELD OPEN FOR 60 DAYS

Bids may be held by the Abington Water Department for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of the bidders prior to establishing the response list. Bidders may not withdraw their bids during this period.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE BID

A complete bid will consist of all the following documents and certifications:

INSURANCE POLICIES

Bidders may amend or modify or withdraw their bids if such amendment, modification or withdrawal is sent in a sealed envelope marked "Amendment, Modification or Withdrawal of ABINGTON WATER DEPARTMENT INVITATION TO BID FOR EMERGENCY EXCAVATION AND PAVING SERVICES " contains the bidder's name and is received at the Abington/Rockland Joint Water Works Office by 9:00 a.m. on September 12, 2024. No late bids or amendments, modifications or withdrawals will be considered. No telegraphic or fax bids will be accepted.

The Abington Water Department reserves the right to waive any informality as to form and to reject any or all bids.

EXCAVATION SERVICES LIST CRITERIA

The Authority for establishing the Excavation and Paving Services List will be the Abington/Rockland Joint Water Works Superintendent. The list will begin with the lowest responsible and responsive bidder and progress to the next lowest responsible and responsive bidder until all respondents are allocated a position on the list. This procurement is governed by the provisions of M.G.L. c,30, \$39M.

DETERMINATION OF LOWEST BID PRICE

The total bid price shall be determined by multiplying the estimated total hours by the unit price of the bidder to reach a total bid price. Each bidder's total bid price is then compared with the other bidder's total prices. The bidder with the lowest total price will be declared the low bidder.

REJECTION OF BIDS

Bids which fail to meet the requirements of the Invitation for bids or which are incomplete, conditional or obscure or which contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind, or in which errors occur, or which in the sole discretion of the Procurement Officer contain abnormally high or abnormally low prices shall be declared non-responsible; provided however, the Abington Water Department if it deems it to be in the public interest, may waive any or all informalities as to form. Informalities as to substance, however, shall not be waived. Alternate bids will not be considered.

METHOD TO BE USED TO AWARD A CONTRACT WHEN THERE IS A TIE

Should there be two or more low bids submitted which are identical and where the bidders are determined to both be responsible, the following procedure shall be used to establish the Excavation Services List.

- a. If there are two bidders with identical bids the first Contractor on the list Contract shall be determined by a toss of a coin. Such a toss shall be done in the presence of the respective bidders.
- b. If there are more than two bidders with identical bids, the coin-toss method shall be used by selecting the first two bidders in alphabetical order and eliminating with a coin toss. This process shall be continued until such time as there remains one bidder.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Provide one (1) backhoe/front end loader with operator to perform duties under the supervision of Water Department personnel.

Provide one (1) dump truck with driver who will also perform the duties of a laborer while on site and work under the supervision of the Water Department personnel.

Provide one (1) Paving Roller with operator to perform duties under the supervision of Water Department personnel.

Provide one (1) Vibratory Compactor with operator who will also perform the duties of a laborer while on site and work under the supervision of the Water Department personnel.

It is estimated that approximately One Hundred (100) hours will be utilized for Excavation Services by June 30, 2027.

It is estimated that approximately One Hundred (100) hours will be utilized for Paving Services by June 30, 2027.

Contractors will be compensated for a minimum four (4) hours at bid prices for any service performed.

APPENDIX A - BID QUOTATION FORM
