WELL REGISTRATION GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED JULY 2000

ANY PERSON, WHO INSTALLS EITHER A DRINKING WATER WELL, OR IRRIGATION WATER WELL ON THEIR PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF ROCKLAND, MUST REGISTER SAME WITH THE BOARD OF HEALTH.

DRINKING WATER WELL	\$75.00
IRRIGATION WATER WELL	\$50.00

TESTING REQUIREMENTS:

DRINKING WATER WELLS MUST HAVE BOTH A FULL WATER CHEMISTRY TEST AND VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS (VOC's). **MUST BE DONE ANNUALLY WITH A COPY SENT TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH.**

IRRIGATION WELL WATER NEED NOT BE TESTED; HOWEVER, A WATER CHEMISTRY TEST IS RECOMMENDED.

A PLAN SHOWING THE LOCATION OF THE WELL ON THE PROPERTY MUST BE FILED WITH THE BOARD OF HEALTH OFFICE ALONG WITH THE REGISTRATION APPLICATION. MINIMUM SETBACKS: 25 FEET FROM SEWER LINE, ABUTTERS AND BUILDINGS; 100-FOOT RADIUS FROM SEPTIC TANK AND its COMPONENTS.

A STATE LICENSED WELL DRILLER MUST INSTALL WELLS.

THE ROCKLAND BOARD OF HEALTH DOES NOT ISSUE PERMITS FOR WELL DRILLING. A NUMBERED CERTIFICATE WILL BE ISSUED AFTER THE WELL IS INSTALLED AND ALL PAPERWORK IS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH OFFICE FOR REVIEW.
