The Board signed the monthly bill vouchers totaling \$518.25

#### Business:

The Board reviewed the Trash Abatements for August 2019. A motion was made by Member Scott Margolis to approve abatements totaling \$518.00 the motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chairman Stephen Nelson. All in favor.

The Board had a brief discussion regarding Trash Fee's and the rising costs in disposal rates. A motion by Vice Chairman Victoria Deibel to increase quarterly trash to \$75.00 was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Member Scott Margolis. All in favor.

#### Appointments:

Stacy Gardner – Rockland C.A.R.E.S./Brockton Area Prevention Collaborative, discussed Bringing a program to Rockland that makes Naloxone nasal spray (Nar-Can) available to those that have a financial need or limited transportation. Currently Naloxone nasal spray is \$71.05 per 2 dose packages. There are grants available to help with the cost. Area communities also have programs such as The Cope Center @ The Manet Health Center in Quincy & Learning to Cope in Hanover.

Introduction of the Town Administrator Doug Lapp & Town Accountant Elizabeth Zaleski to the Board of Health members.

### Office Update:

Health Agent Delshaune Flipp discussed with the Board Members, A proposal of Composting Partnership for the leaf pile at the Recycling Center from Black Earth Compost & M Gardner LLC.

Health Agent Delshaune Flipp discussed CBD being served at food establishments around surrounding towns. Agent Flipp stated that there are no regulations set by the state yet, however, other towns have adopted their own regulations only allowing prepackaged to be sold in retail establishments. Health Agent Delshaune Flipp suggested that CBD products be sold in 21+ only Smoke Shops which would limit the exposure & access for children to purchase.

Blanket Authorization Form for Hazardous Waste is on town website with link to SSRC.

Health Agent Delshaune Flipp stated that there have been zero cases of EEE from Mosquitos in the town of Rockland. Residents can call Plymouth County Mosquito Control for spraying.

Kevin Cameron has accepted the full-time position @ the Recycling Center to begin 8/15/19. Dan Stoddard will act as backup when needed.

Health Agent Delshaune Flipp discussed with the Board the possibility of changing the Recycle Center hours on Sundays. Chairman Stephen Nelson suggested staying open a total of 5.0 hours. One attendant work 9am-12pm and the other attendant work 11am-2pm.
